The fee for participation is \$250.00 for all 3 days, and observers (no dog) are also welcome and will pay \$50.00. All applications are accepted first-come, first-served, are limited to 10 working dogs and must be accompanied by a \$100.00 non-refundable deposit.

Confirmation of your reservation will be made when your application is received.

This will be a working seminar, so expect to do yard drills with your dog each day, as well as marks on land and water and any additional drills appropriate for your dog. We will shoot flyers as needed. We will provide a continental breakfast each morning of the seminar, and will take a short lunch break around noon. Please provide your own drinks, snacks and lunch. We will organize a group dinner at a local restaurant for one evening of the seminar; otherwise you are on your own for dinner.

We will be working outdoors as much as possible, so please be prepared. You will want to bring a lawn chair, any equipment you are using with your dog, a pen or pencil for note-taking and appropriate gear for the expected weather. You can check the online weather forecast for Athens, GA (zip: 30683) before arrival for more details, but we do expect mild weather (50` - 70` daytime temps) and that part of February/March is typically dry.

As in the past, we wish to invite all seminar participants to spend a few extra days with us at no charge (except for flyers!) to train for the 3 days between seminars

Marks and blinds will be the primary focus of this training time, and we ask that participants be willing to take turns throwing birds. We will have a hired bird boy on hand, who is able to shoot flyers. We expect to have pigeons and ducks available to train with. Please indicate if you will be attending this training time, so that we can best determine a schedule. Private lessons for drills/problem-solving will be available at our hourly rate of \$40/hr and must be arranged in advance.

Once your application has been received, we will confirm via mail or email. Directions and a list of dog- friendly motels in the Athens area are available on our website. Please get in touch with us if you need any more information.
